By staying out of the fairways this past off-season, the Bermuda will hopefully grow-in faster and provide a better turf quality.

We have started a sand trap edging program that is beginning to look

wonderful. We are also improving the draining system on some of the troublesome bunkers. This will hopefully improve the aesthetics of the course and the playability of the sand traps.

We have built a new tee for #12. The new yardage will be 125-140 yards. This will mainly serve as the green tee but will occasionally serve as the white tee as well.

The upcoming spring weather will change the course conditions on a daily basis, so be sure to check with the pro-shop before playing for any golf cart restrictions. Until the fairways turn, we will continue to be rough-only for the cart usage. As always, please keep the carts on the paths around tees and, especially, the greens.
